

Using The Nokia 6212 to Access “Touch”

Logging on to the phone

Switch the phone on by holding down the on/off button located on the very top of the phone above the screen.

As long as all steps of the Remote Install Guide have been completed (ask your Manager), you will be presented with the top level Nokia screen, with the following icon positioned at the top...



By clicking on the icon, the Touch application will open. You will then be presented with a log-in screen, where you need to enter your log-in details as allocated to you by your manager.

Once entered, select “login” and you will be asked...

“Allow network access? This application is not from a trusted supplier”.

Click “Yes”. As long as all three steps contained within the Application Remote Install Guide have been followed, then this question will only be asked when you first log into the application.

When the phone says “Touch is listening” and the Touch logo is displayed, then you have successfully logged onto the application.

If you enter the wrong details then you will be informed and given the opportunity to re-enter your details. If it keeps failing then ask your Manager if you have the correct username and password.

Swiping Tags

It should be remembered that the RFID reader is located at the bottom of the battery compartment on the back of the phone. RFID tags are most successfully swiped if you hold the phone between your thumb and forefinger at the top of the device, and touch the battery cover at the back of the phone against the RFID tag, towards the bottom. When successfully swiped, the phone will beep and vibrate.
